Lt. Col. John Pierce St. John
(1833-1916); (Rep/Prohibition/People's); (lawyer)

(born Brookville, Franklin co. IN); (moved to California, 1852; fought in Indians wars, 1853-54); (traveled to Central & South America, Sandwich Islands-Hawaii, Mexico, 1854-59)
(moved to Illinois, 1859); (Union Army); (moved to Independence, Missouri, then Olathe, Kansas)
(KS senate, 1873); (Governor of Kansas, 1879-83)

(supported KS Freedmen's Relief Association, 1879, to settle ex-slaves in Kansas; backed Prohibition law of 1881); (Prohibitionist Party Candidate for US President, 1884)

(1832-at least 1859); (divorce)

Henry Clay St. John
(1852-96)

= Susan Jane Parker (1838-1928)
(parents from GA/IL)

(alcoholic; convicted of murdering 2d wife but died before execution)
