(1934-); (Dem/Green/Independent)
(born Winstead, Litchfield co. CT); (lawyer/journalist/author/consumer advocate)
(professor of history & government at University of Hartford, 1961-63)
(moved to Washington DC as staffer in US Department of Labor)
(wrote best-selling book, "Unsafe at Any Speed: The Designed-In Dangers of the American Automobile, 1966)
(founder/director, Public Citizen non-governmental organization to push tighter government regulation of water, food, product safety)
(helped persuade Congress to pass the Safe Drinking Water Act, the Freedom of Information Act,
and to create the Occupation Safety & Health Administration, the US Environmental Protection Agency, & the Consumer Products Safety Council)
(quadrennial Candidate for US President as Independent, 1992-2008, including as Green Party Candidate in 2004)
