(born Bow, Merrimac co. NH); (began hearing voices/healing farm animals, 1829)
(freed 1st husband's slaves, 1844); (ill health provoked search for solutions, including hypnotism of Phineas Quimby of ME)
(suffered spinal injury from fall, 1866); (moved to Lynn MA, 1866); (Bible readings, 1866-69; claimed divine inspiration for her interpretations)
(founder, First Church of Christ Scientist); (healing by clearer perception of God; no drugs/medicines); (author, Science & Health, 1875)
(moved to Boston MA, 1879); (founder, Christian Science Forward, 1883, then Christian Science Monitor newspaper, 1908)
(adopted another son)
