(1824-86); (Dem); (twin)
(born Montgomeryville, Montgomery co. PA)
(US Army, 1844-86; in Florida, Kansas, Utah, California before Civil War)
(Union General with Army of Potomac, 1861-65; Gettysburg/wounded; friend of Confederate General Lewis Armistead)
(supervised execution of assassins of President Abraham Lincoln, 1865)
(US Commander, Department of Missouri, 1866-67; of 5th Military District during Reconstruction for TX & LA, 1867-69; of Department of Dakotas, 1869-72; of Department of Atlantic from NYC, 1872-86)
(Democratic Party Candidate for US President, 1880); (president, National Rifle Association, 1881-)
