(born Natchitoches LA)

(moved to Texarkana, Texas, 1860s or 1870s)

(merchant/grocer); (trading post/general store/car dealer)

= Maggie H. ??? (1875-at least 1910)

Gabriel Elias "Ross" Perot II (1900-55); (cotton buyer/horse dealer)

= Lulu May Ray (1897-1979); (secretary/teacher)

Lt. Henry Ross Perot I (1930-); (Rep & Reform)

(born Henry Ray Perot; changed name at death of brother Gabriel Ross Perot III)

(US Navy, 1953-57); (IBM computer salesman, 1957-62); (founder/CEO, Electronic Data Systems, 1962-84; data processing services, including computerized Medicare records; sold company to GM for \$2.4 billion)

(founder/CEO, Perot Systems Corp., 1988-2000; chairman, -2004; chairman emeritus, 2004-); (net worth in 2007, \$4.4 billion)

(Independent Candidate for US President, 1992, with 19.7 million votes or 19%); (founder, Reform Party, 1995); (Reform Party Candidate for US President, 1996, with 8 million votes or 8.8%)
