Thomas Boone
 (1730-1812); (Tory/Loyalist)
 (inherited 2,000 acres in South Carolina
 from cousin Anne Colleton,
 then Boone's Barony with 6,815 acres
 from widow of Uncle Joseph, 1751)
 (Emigrated from England to
 South Carolina, 1751-53, then 1758)
 (Governor of New Jersey, 1759-61; arrived 1760;
 wrangled with NJ assembly over tax money
 and militia for war with France)
 (returned to South Carolina, 1761)
 (Governor of South Carolina, 1761-66;
 (reduced powers of SC assembly,
 which then refused to meet;
 summoned to London, 1764, censored by
 Board of Trade, and never returned to SC
 (British customs commissioner, 1769-1805)
 (property in SC confiscated, 1782;
 received 22,500 pounds sterling compensation
 from British government)

 (Governor of Oregon Territory, 1853, 1854-59)
 (jewelry manufacturer); (led OR militia in Yakima War, 1865)
