(1905-66); (American Labor)  
(born Gourtoughera, County Kerry, Ireland); (saw mill worker/carpenter's apprentice/woodcutter)  
(dispatch rider for Irish Republican Army, 1919-21; Irish Civil War, 1922-23)  
(blacklisted after Irish Civil War; emigrated to New York City, 1926); (ticket agent, Interborough Rapid Transit Co., 1929-)  
(helped found/president, Transport Workers Union, 1934-66; ally of Communist Party, 1936-48, then broke off relationship)  
(NYC city council, 1937-46); (transit strike of 1937 to establish union; NYC 1966 transit strike)
